Guiding Principle I: Infrastructure and Shared Leadership

Objective: Establish a vision for achieving educational equity through core beliefs and norms, team structures and routines, clarity of roles and data-based decision-making process, professional learning, and system alignment.

- During professional development on April 27, I presented key points from our external visit exit report to all staff. The full report is available to all staff on Canvas.
- Building level teams have been established. Each building chose 7 teachers to be members of each team. Each team has one member who is also on the District Leadership Team. These teams have the responsibility of examining tier 1 core instruction and supports for all students, ensure students receive tier 2 supports as needed, collect schoolwide data to determine the effectiveness of schoolwide systems, ensure fidelity of evidence-based practices, communicate progress to stakeholders, and determine needed resources through data analysis. We are able to engage building level teams because we have an established data profile and we will be able to look at district data through the use of EduClimber. The absence of building level teams has created a feeling of disconnect among staff and in essence, has created a perception that all decisions are made by the District Leadership Team. Engaging our building level teams will bridge the gap between the District Leadership Team and grade level teams. Two areas that will be prioritized as focus for the building level teams are our intervention systems and ensuring the fidelity of our instructional model at tier 1. Engaging our building level teams aligns with recommendations given by the external visit team—continue strengthening MTSS systems and evaluate effectiveness of systems over time. Building level team members will participate in an upcoming training on the use of EduClimber. In the fall, I intend to help prepare team facilitators to lead these teams.

Guiding Principle II: Layered Continuum of Supports

Objective: Provide tiered supports to meet the social, emotional, behavioral, physical, environmental, and academic needs of the whole child to ensure student growth.

- The HAL team had work time on April 20 to continue the development of our district HAL plan. The plan is very close to completion, but a few decisions have yet to be made. We will not hit our intended deadline to have a completed HAL plan before school ends. We will continue the work in the fall with the intention to provide needed professional development to staff during the first semester of the 2026-2027 school. Implementation would then begin during the second semester.

Guiding Principle III: Data-Based Decision-Making

Objective: Community, caregivers, district, school, collaborative and student support teams use a variety of data points to identify student needs and support planning. This includes a balanced assessment system to generate data, data-based decision-making to reinforce student support, and data-based decision-making to support continuous improvement of systems.

- The Targeted Improvement Plan (TIP) was completed and submitted on time. The new platform and requirements were much more rigorous than in the past. One aspect that served us well as we prepared our plan is that we have a very comprehensive CIP. We easily made connections between the two plans, which also proved that we no longer have plans living in silos, but in coherence with each other.
- On May 8, we received a closeout letter from the NDE Office of Special Education stating the following:

On January 5, 2026, Wakefield Public Schools was issued a letter of noncompliance for Indicator 13: Secondary Transition, which included an outline of the required corrective action steps that needed to be completed and corrected. The Nebraska Department of Education, Office of Special Education, has reviewed the documents submitted by the district. We are pleased to inform you that all noncompliance has been corrected, and no further action is due for the 2025-2026 Indicator 13 Secondary Transition Monitoring Process.

Guiding Principle IV: Communication and Collaboration

Objective: Enhance student, family, and community engagement with learning experiences that are culturally inclusive and relevant for each student. Student success and engagement rely on positive partnerships and relationships to fundamentally improve the outcomes for each student, school, district, and community.

- I sent out the annual perceptual survey. The survey used was the NEP perceptual surveys for students (grades 3-12), certified staff, classified staff, and parent/guardian. These surveys align with AQuESST domains and tenets. The results will inform our district of perceptions in the areas of environment, relationships, engagement, and instruction. Results will be documented in our data profile. PDF versions of the surveys are available on the NDE website. I created Google forms with the survey prompts as an efficient way to collect data. By creating our own Google forms, I was also able to provide Spanish translation to maximize participation of our students and parents/guardians. The surveys close May 13.

ELPA21 Spring 2026 Testing Report

Wakefield Community Schools recently completed ELPA21 testing for the 2025–2026 school year, and I am very pleased to report significant progress in the performance and growth of our English Learner (EL) students.

A total of 113 students participated in ELPA21 testing this spring. Results are summarized below:

- **17 students** scored **Proficient**
- **34 students** scored **On Track**
- **19 students** demonstrated **Partial Progress**
- **43 students** were identified as **Not On Track**

Students who achieve a **Proficient** score on the ELPA21 assessment have successfully met the state's English language proficiency requirements and are no longer required to take the ELPA21 assessment annually. This is a tremendous accomplishment for both students and staff and represents meaningful progress in language acquisition and academic readiness.

Under the ELPA21 accountability model, districts receive:

- **1 point** for every student who scores **Proficient** or **On Track**
- **0.5 points** for every student demonstrating **Partial Progress**

Using this formula, Wakefield Community Schools achieved an overall ELPA21 proficiency/growth rate of **53.5%** for 2026.

For comparison:

- **2026:** 53.5%
- **2025:** 44.1%
- **2024:** 31.48%
- **2023:** 45.95%

The 2026 results represent the highest ELPA21 performance and growth rate during my time as an administrator at Wakefield Community Schools. This progress is a direct reflection of the dedication, expertise, and collaboration of our EL staff and support personnel.

These educators accomplished this work despite our certified EL staff decreasing this year from six certified staff members to four.

I would also like to extend special appreciation to paraprofessionals:

- **Tina Nurenberger**

Their support, particularly at the high school level, was instrumental in helping our EL students succeed. Additionally, many other paraprofessionals and staff members contributed to this success through teamwork and collaboration across the district.

I believe several factors contributed to these strong results:

- Outstanding and dedicated EL teachers and support staff
- Improved systems and scheduling structures to ensure students consistently receive EL intervention services
- Better coordination for students who qualify for both EL and Special Education services
- Continued refinement and implementation of more effective curriculum and instructional resources

Historically, students who were dually identified as EL and Special Education sometimes faced scheduling barriers that impacted consistent EL intervention time. Through adjustments to staffing and scheduling, we have made significant improvements to ensure all EL students receive the services and instructional support they need.

The team also did an excellent job evaluating and implementing more efficient and effective curriculum resources, and we continue to refine those supports moving forward.

Overall, these results are extremely encouraging and provide strong evidence that our systems, instructional practices, and collaborative efforts are moving in a very positive direction. I look forward to continued growth and improvement in the years ahead.

Transportation Department Update and Bus Fleet Needs

The administration would like to provide the Board of Education with an update regarding district transportation needs and the status of recent bus repairs and fleet considerations.

The district bus that was recently damaged has now received a repair estimate totaling approximately \$18,000. At this time, the matter remains in the hands of the district's insurance

provider. The district's deductible for this claim is \$500, and we are currently awaiting the insurance company's determination regarding whether the bus will be repaired or declared a total loss.

Based on discussions and the condition of the vehicle, I believe the insurance company will likely move forward with repairs. The bus contains a strong and reliable engine model, and in my opinion, the vehicle remains worth repairing. However, the final decision rests with the insurance provider.

In addition to the accident-related repairs, the district continues to experience ongoing transportation challenges connected to aging fleet equipment and increased operational demands.

The district's 2014 bus has recently experienced significant mechanical issues. Current estimates indicate a minimum repair cost of approximately \$16,500, with the possibility of an additional \$9,000 in repairs. Importantly, the repair provider has stated there is no guarantee that these repairs will fully resolve the underlying mechanical problems or restore long-term reliability. This creates a substantial financial risk, as the district could potentially invest up to \$25,000 into a vehicle that may still remain unreliable.

At the same time, the district continues to operate in a very high-demand transportation environment involving:

- Daily student routes
- Extracurricular activities
- Academic competitions
- Field trips
- Athletic travel
- Summer transportation needs

Limited bus availability has already impacted scheduling flexibility and operational efficiency during several portions of the school year.

Because of these concerns, I continue to recommend that the district consider returning to a five-bus fleet, as the district has maintained in previous years. I do want to apologize to the Board for somewhat rushing the transportation agenda item last month during an especially busy season of activities and scheduling demands.

Now that we are moving beyond many of our busiest spring events, the administration and transportation department will take additional time to complete a more thorough review process before bringing forward any recommendation. Transportation Director Dwight Vandervin will lead this effort.

Prior to the next board meeting, the administration will:

- Conduct additional due diligence regarding bus options
- Review multiple vendors and providers

- Examine pricing and financing structures
- Evaluate warranty and maintenance considerations
- Provide detailed information to both the transportation committee and the full Board of Education

The proposed options under consideration include a new 59-passenger bus equipped with updated safety features, modern mechanical systems, and warranty coverage designed to reduce long-term maintenance uncertainty and operational disruptions.

Financing options will also be presented for board review, including multiple payment structures and term lengths that align with the district's financial planning goals.

Given the uncertainty surrounding costly repairs to aging vehicles, combined with the district's immediate operational transportation needs, the administration believes that purchasing an additional bus may ultimately represent the most reliable, safe, and fiscally responsible long-term solution for Wakefield Community Schools.

Secondary Principal Report – Mr. Brenn

- Total 7-12 enrollment: 224
- STAR testing is complete for grades 7-12 and NSCAS testing is scheduled for Apr 13 – May 2
- reVision refresh document has been updated and submitted to NDE.
 - This is a requirement for every district and community college in Nebraska desiring to operate as an approved CTE program and receive federal or state CTE grant funds. The update occurs every two years.
 - Thanks to the help of the CTE department staff in assisting me with updating our document prior to submission.

Director of Student Services Report – Mrs. Zach

- The District Leadership Team met briefly during the April in-service day. We reviewed the feedback the external visit team gave us regarding perceptual surveys. We also discussed when and where to hold our DLT retreat in May.
- The HAL team attended a HAL workshop at the ESU on March 24. Sheyanne Smith of NDE led the workshop. We learned about the new requirements for HAL. Many resources were shared including a template to create a HAL plan, a documentation checklist, and a self-assessment rubric to ensure our HAL program framework is hitting all requirements of Rule 3.
- Cathy Hoffart and I attended the TIP workshop at ESU1 on March 11. The TIP submission has changed platforms which also means a completely different look in how information is organized. A new component was added to address access to assistive technology. As this information was presented, it seemed disconnected from the TIP. It seemed more like a compliance measure that should exist outside of the TIP. It will be a new component to navigate. The way that the TIP is organized now easily aligns with our CIP.
- I recently had a meeting with secondary staff. We discussed ways that we could give more attention to student accomplishments and successes rather than relying on punitive consequences to change behaviors such as poor attendance or poor academic responsibility. One incentive we would like to implement is a Senior Privilege Period. Seniors who are in good credit, grades, and attendance standing could earn a period in which they could be off-campus. This would be in the senior's schedule at the beginning of the day or end of the day.

Superintendent/Elementary Principal Report

- We will review and discuss the external visit exit report later in this meeting; however, I would like to take a moment to recognize and express my appreciation for the work of our District Leadership Team over the past five years and throughout the recent external visit process. I would also like to specifically recognize Angela Zach for her leadership in guiding this team. I believe this culture of collaboration, professional growth, and shared ownership was evident throughout the visit and will be reflected in the team's final exit report. The work of the District Leadership Team has been outstanding, and the systems they have helped build will continue to strengthen our district moving forward.
- Several education-related bills were debated during the recent legislative session, with varying outcomes impacting school districts.
 - LB 1050 (Nebraska Reading Improvement Act) aimed to improve early literacy by requiring students to read at grade level by the end of third grade, including a retention requirement for those who did not meet expectations. The bill ultimately failed to advance after a cloture vote.

- LB 803 was amended to include provisions affecting school district budgeting processes. Key components require all districts to participate in “pink postcard” hearings between July 1 and July 15, with counties notifying property owners of hearing details. Additionally, any increase in a district’s property tax request must be approved by at least a two-thirds majority of the school board. This bill passed on final reading.
 - Importantly, this hearing will be based on preliminary—not final—valuation and budget data, allowing time for adjustments before final decisions are made in the fall.
- LB 1219 proposed a strict 2% cap on property tax request increases for governmental entities, including schools. While there were discussions about possible modifications, the bill did not advance and failed to gain traction, providing relief to school districts concerned about its potential impact.
- Administrative Staffing Update
 - Mr. Brenn will transition primarily into a teaching role while continuing to assist the district with attendance, student welfare, and other assigned responsibilities as his schedule allows. Due to Mr. Brenn assuming a significant teaching load, it is no longer sustainable or in the best interest of the secondary building for him to also serve as high school principal. Effective next school year, Angie Zach will serve as the full-time 7–12 principal. In addition to this role, Mrs. Zach will continue as the District Special Education Coordinator, including supervision of 7–12 special education staff and oversight of all required state reporting. She will also serve as the district’s MTSS Coordinator, helping lead and strengthen our systems of support.

At the elementary level, Mrs. Wright and I will provide increased support for special education services from birth through grade 6, including oversight of IEP processes to ensure compliance, quality, and timeliness. Mrs. Zach, Mrs. Wright, and I will continue to collaborate closely to support ongoing school improvement efforts.

Paige Wooster - Elementary Classroom Teacher

Following the recent resignation of an English Learner (EL) instructor, the district conducted a review of current staffing levels and student needs within the EL program. Based on this review, it was determined that maintaining adequate staffing in EL is essential to effectively serve our student population.

As part of a strategic staffing solution, the district explored internal realignment opportunities. A current elementary teacher with an EL endorsement has expressed interest in transitioning into an EL role, which would strengthen the district’s ability to meet the instructional needs of English Learners. This transition, however, is contingent upon the district’s ability to fill the resulting elementary classroom vacancy.

Motion to approve the initial certified employment contract for Paige Wooster - Elementary Classroom Teacher passed with a motion by Riewer and a second by Haglund.

Consideration and possible approval of the purchase of a new school bus to replace the district's 2014 bus due to significant mechanical concerns and ongoing transportation needs.

The district's 2014 bus has recently experienced significant mechanical issues. The estimated cost to repair the bus is a minimum of \$16,500, with the potential for an additional \$9,000 in repairs. Importantly, the repair provider has indicated there is no guarantee that these repairs will resolve the issue or fully address the underlying problem. This creates a substantial financial risk of investing up to \$25,000 into a vehicle that may remain unreliable.

At the same time, the district is currently in a high-demand period for transportation services, including daily routes, activities, field trips, and extracurricular events. Limited bus availability is already impacting scheduling flexibility and operational efficiency.

In response, the administration is recommending the purchase of a new bus to ensure safe, reliable, and consistent transportation for students. The proposed bus options include a 59-passenger bus with modern safety features, updated mechanical systems, and warranty coverage to reduce long-term maintenance uncertainty.

Financing options have also been provided for board consideration, including multiple term lengths and payment structures to align with the district's financial planning needs.

Given the uncertainty of repair outcomes, the high cost of potential repairs, and the immediate operational need, purchasing a new bus is a more reliable and fiscally responsible long-term solution.

Motion to approve the purchase of a new school bus as presented in the attached proposals and authorize the administration to proceed with finalizing the purchase up to \$144,200 outright failed with a motion by Lundahl and a second by Riewer.

Consideration and possible approval of a revision to the 2025–2026 school calendar to move the last day of school from May 15th to May 13th, with a 1:00 p.m. dismissal.

At this time, the district is well above the required number of instructional hours, and the likelihood of additional weather-related cancellations is low. If the current calendar remains unchanged, the district will complete the school year with approximately 1,129.45 instructional hours, which is 6.6 days above the state minimum requirement.

Under the proposed adjustment, moving the last student day to May 13th would result in approximately 1,115.9 instructional hours, which still exceeds the minimum requirement by 4.78 days. This ensures full compliance while allowing for a more efficient end-of-year schedule.

There are several operational and staff-related benefits to this adjustment:

- It allows a group of teachers to complete required professional development on May 14th during contract time, eliminating the need for additional paid days later.
- It provides May 14th and 15th for principals to conduct end-of-year checkout meetings with staff in a more flexible and meaningful manner.
- It eliminates the need for staff to report in person on May 18th, while still honoring contract obligations. Staff would have the option to report or submit eight hours of work, consistent with prior flexibility provided earlier in the year.
- Teachers' contract hours would still be accounted for.

Overall, this adjustment maintains instructional requirements while improving efficiency, supporting staff, and allowing for a more thoughtful close to the school year.

Motion to approve the revision to the 2025-2026 school calendar, moving the last day of school to May 13th with a 1:00 p.m. dismissal, while maintaining compliance with all required instructional hours passed with a motion by Dorcey and a second by Haglund.

Consideration and possible approval of a contract with RSW Floor Company to apply Premera T2™ single-component spray to elementary terrazzo floors.

This treatment would replace the district's current annual waxing and recoating process in those areas. The total cost of the project is **\$19,738**, which includes product application and an associated protection/repair assurance. Premera T2 (specifically T2 MCM) is a single-component, spray-applied, sol-gel nano-coating designed as a high-performance clear topcoat for concrete, terrazzo, and epoxy floors. It creates a durable, self-leveling, and quartz-mineral barrier that offers superior chemical, scratch, and abrasion resistance without requiring backrolling or extensive sanding.

The district currently maintains terrazzo flooring through routine waxing and recoating, which requires ongoing material costs, staff time, and repeated annual labor. The proposed Primera T2 nanocoating offers a long-term alternative designed to significantly reduce maintenance demands while improving durability.

Motion to approve the contract with RSW Floor Company in the amount of \$19,738 for the application of Premera T2 nanocoating to the elementary terrazzo hallways, including associated repair assurance, and authorize the administration to proceed with implementation passed with a motion by Dorcey and a second by Haglund.

Grade Scale Comparison Analysis Summary

Wakefield Community Schools has engaged in a comprehensive continuous improvement process focused on strengthening Tier 1 instruction, increasing student outcomes, and aligning systems to support all learners. As part of this reflection, the district has identified that its current grading scale may not fully reflect the level of rigor and precision needed to accurately measure student proficiency and growth.

A comparison of grading scales across neighboring districts highlights a clear trend toward more rigorous and differentiated grading practices. Wakefield currently uses a traditional grading scale in which an “A” begins at 93% and a “B” begins at 80%, with relatively broad performance bands. While this structure is common, it is less precise when compared to surrounding schools.

Neighboring districts such as Pender, Wayne, and Wisner-Pilger utilize more refined grading bands, often incorporating narrower percentage ranges and additional grade distinctions (e.g., A-, B-, C-) to better differentiate levels of student performance. For example, Wayne’s grading scale begins an “A” at 95% and includes multiple subdivisions that provide greater clarity on student performance within each grade range. Similarly, Pender uses tightly defined ranges that more clearly distinguish between levels of mastery and proficiency.

Other districts, such as West Point-Beemer and Emerson-Hubbard, demonstrate a commitment to rigor through grading systems that either raise proficiency thresholds or align grades more closely with performance descriptors tied to mastery levels. These systems more explicitly connect grades to student understanding and readiness rather than broad percentage groupings.

Additionally, several districts emphasize grading practices that reflect college and career readiness expectations, including more stringent cut scores for proficiency and clearer alignment between grades and performance outcomes. In comparison, Wakefield’s current scale may allow for higher grades without the same level of demonstrated mastery, potentially limiting the accuracy of data used for instructional decision-making and student readiness indicators.

This comparison underscores that Wakefield’s grading scale is less rigorous and less precise than many surrounding districts. As a result, it may not fully support the district’s goals of increasing student achievement, strengthening Tier 1 instruction, and ensuring equitable access to high expectations for all students.

Aligning Wakefield’s grading scale to a more rigorous model would:

- Provide more accurate data on student proficiency
- Better support identification of High Ability Learners
- Reinforce high expectations aligned to district improvement goals
- Strengthen instructional decision-making and assessment practices
- Ensure consistency with regional expectations and postsecondary readiness

Ultimately, transitioning to a more rigorous grading scale is a natural next step in Wakefield’s continuous improvement journey. It aligns grading practices with the district’s mission and

instructional model, ensuring that student performance is measured in a way that reflects true mastery, supports growth, and prepares all students for success beyond high school.

Rationale:

Wakefield Community Schools is grounded in the Trojan mission to embrace diversity, educate and support the whole learner, and empower students to be critical thinkers, lifelong learners, and global citizens. Over the past five years, the district has engaged in a rigorous and intentional continuous improvement process, using data to build sustainable systems that support student success. Through this work, we have closely examined our Tier 1 instructional practices, identifying both strengths and areas for growth. This has led to the development and implementation of a locally designed instructional model that reflects the unique needs of our student population and ensures access to high-quality instruction for all learners.

As we continue to reflect on and refine our systems, it has become clear that our current secondary grading scale does not fully align with the high expectations we hold for our students or the instructional practices we are striving to implement. A more rigorous grading scale provides an opportunity to more accurately measure student proficiency and better reflect student learning. This shift allows instructional staff to more effectively evaluate student performance and use that data to inform instructional decisions and assessment practices.

Increasing the rigor of our grading scale directly supports our continuous improvement goals. Higher expectations for all students align with our ELA CIP and TIP goals, pushing students toward greater growth and achievement. It also strengthens our ability to accurately identify students for programs such as High Ability Learners (HAL), ensuring that students who demonstrate advanced proficiency are appropriately recognized and supported. At the same time, this shift reinforces expectations for teachers to implement Universal Design for Learning (UDL) practices, ensuring that all students have equitable access to instruction and the opportunity to meet higher standards.

We recognize that increasing rigor must be accompanied by strong systems of support. Wakefield has intentionally developed structures within our MTSS framework to provide layered supports for students who need additional assistance. A more rigorous grading scale not only challenges students but also compels us as a system to strengthen these supports, ensuring that all students have the opportunity to succeed. This includes refining intervention practices, strengthening Tier 1 instruction, and ensuring that data is used consistently to respond to student needs.

This shift highlights the importance of fidelity in instructional practices. A more rigorous grading system requires us to be intentional in monitoring and evaluating how instruction is delivered, ensuring that all students have consistent access to high-quality learning experiences. This reinforces our commitment to ongoing reflection, data analysis, and continuous improvement.

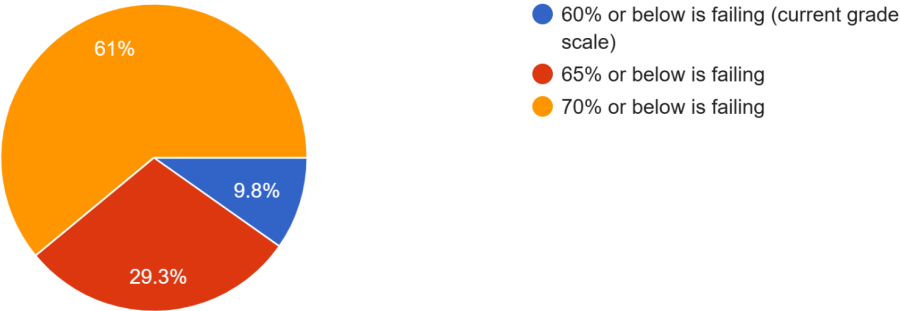

May 1, 2026

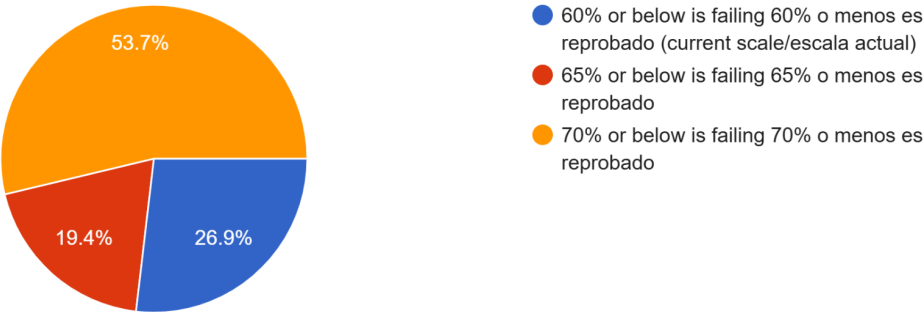
Staff survey

Summary of results: The district conducted surveys of both staff and parents/guardians to gather input on preferred grading scale thresholds for failing grades. A total of 41 staff members and 67 parents/guardians responded to the survey.

Staff responses indicate a strong preference for a more rigorous grading scale. The majority of staff members, 61%, prefer a scale in which 70% or below is considered failing. An additional 29.3% support a threshold of 65% or below as failing, while only 9.8% favor maintaining the current scale in which 60% or below is considered failing. Overall, the results suggest that staff members largely support raising the failing threshold, with nearly two-thirds favoring the most rigorous option presented.

Parent and guardian responses also reflect a preference for a higher failing threshold, although opinions are more varied than those of staff. A majority of respondents, 53.7%, prefer a grading scale in which 70% or below is considered failing. Another 19.4% support a threshold of 65% or below, while 26.9% favor maintaining the current standard of 60% or below as failing. These results indicate that while most parents and guardians support increasing the rigor of the grading scale, a notable portion prefer to keep the current system in place.

Overall, both staff and parents/guardians demonstrate a clear trend toward supporting an increase in the failing grade threshold to 70%. Staff responses show stronger consensus, whereas parent and guardian responses reflect a broader range of perspectives.
