Superintendent Purdy led by thanking Alphonso Mata for his time and service to the Board of Education. He thanked everyone and announced his resignation from the Board of Education as he had recently moved in town and is no longer in his ward. Next, the GHS Swim Team was recognized for their achievements at State. They brought home 13 medals; the boys' team placed 9th overall and the girls' team placed 16th overall. Katie Lindsay spoke to the Board members about updating the online directory. It has been a large undertaking, but she only has about 25 staff members remaining to get on the directory. She plans to have it completed by spring break. Superintendent Purdy gave an update on the bond progress. She noted that the waterline relocation project is underway. The gusty winds last week blew down the fencing around the work site, but it has all been put back up. Some dirt work is also being done for the new school since the weather has been good lately.

We have closed on the old Warren CAT building and are currently waiting to get occupancy. Lastly, Superintendent Purdy mentioned that Leadership Oklahoma will be here in April.
