Saline County 4-H is planning to again host the 4-H Archery Contest in the Driftwood Walking Trail area, and entering into a portion of the Lakebed area of Tuxedo Park. The proposed date for the contest is Sunday, August 20 beginning at 9 a.m. with shooting to commence approximately 3 p.m.

Due to the anticipated surge of campers and visitors in the park area for the total solar eclipse on Monday, August 21, we would increase the number of posted TRAIL CLOSED signs, and urge our participants to use extra caution as they travel through the course. None of our stations shoot across the path, they may shoot from the walking trail or from a short spur off the trail to the targets placed further away from the path/walking trail. We could have an extra person watching the trail entrance near the river bridge to keep foot traffic from entering the trail during the shoot if deemed necessary.

Driftwood Trail follows the old dike in the wooded area east of the red area that contains the lakebed on the map. We do not venture any further west than the east edge of the rectangular track location seen on the map of Camper and Tent Spaces provided to me by Police Chief Hensel.
