She made changes to the process cycle which she feels will greatly improve our treatment process.

As for the shop itself it is good and the guys take good care of it. After going out one night in the dark to help load salt and realized how dark it was behind the building, NPPD will be adding two lights in that area. We are looking into upgrading some equipment this year, I have a quote for a back hoe waiting on a grant. We will replace a pickup and maybe a dump truck this year as well. Behind the shop is the manhole for dumping that Darling uses as well as septic haulers. We plan to concrete around that area to create a catch area in case of spills.
